Arabella and her late husband Willie were owners of a taxi company named Partlow Cab Company. After the death of her husband, she renamed the company to Blue Bell Cab Co. Church for over 50 years where she served on the Deacons' board. Years later she became a member of the St. John Baptist Church.
