Collis Hyizher Wheeler completed his journey on earth June 23, 2016 at the age of 99. He was born April 29, 1917 to the late Thomas Milligan and Susie Hall Wheeler in Carnesville (Franklin County) Georgia. He attended Union Grove Church School and joined the Army Air Force, proudly serving his country from March 24, 1943 to February 19, 1946 receiving an honorable discharge.

In July 1951, he married the love of his life Edna Dorothy Gayles and to this union one child was born Beatrice Patricia Wheeler. They were married for 56 years.

He was a faithful member of St. Luke Baptist Church in Laurelton New York, serving as Trustee, Deacon, Chairman of the Deacon Board and Pastor's Aide.
