*The last time I saw him, I encouraged him to go sit outside and get some fresh air so he wasn't sitting in the dark watching TV as always.*

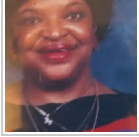
*I said "It's a beautiful day to be outside." It wasn't hot that day and he was just doing what he always did.*
