Pastor Johnnie Lee Mayweather was born in Hancock, Ga March 17 1933 by the late Johnnie L. Mayweather & Odessa Mae Jones. He leaves behind his wife Patricia Lynn Mayweather of 49 years. His 13 children including Johnnie Jr (deceased), Turrom, Ann, Valerie, Donell, Angela, David, Carolyn, Steven, Stacey, Tony, Christopher and Chantell.
