



## Leroy Williams

September 13, 1925 - May 8, 2023

Leroy Williams (96) was born September 13, 1926, in Montgomery, Alabama, to the late James and Jannie Williams. Leroy enlisted into the Military at the young age of 17, to assist his family.

After finishing his tour of duty in the Navy he returned to Montgomery. Once back at home in Montgomery he learned of a program to continue his education. This Program was being taught at St. Jude's Catholic Church. While there at St. Jude's he decided to join their Church. He received a diploma from St. Jude's for the studies he completed in the Program.

After receiving his diploma, he applied for a job with the CDC in Montgomery.

On May 28, 1958, Leroy was united in holy matrimony to Mary Williams at age 32, in Montgomery, Alabama. Leroy and Mary moved to Atlanta, Georgia in 1962, as result of his job transfer. To this union, one child was born, Stephanie Williams. Stephanie was born at Holy Family Hospital here in Atlanta. While there he spoke with the Nuns about Catholic Churches in the area. They told him about St. Paul of the Cross Catholic Church which was in their neighborhood. Leroy joined St. Paul in 1969. Stephanie was Baptized there as a baby.

Leroy retired from the CDC after 40 years of service.

Two sisters and seven brothers preceded him in death.

Leroy departed from this life on Monday, May 8, 2023, to be present with the Lord.

He leaves to cherish his memory, a loving daughter, Stephanie Williams; brother, Wilbur Williams (Chicago Illinois); special niece, Lesha Ann and Calvin Thomas; a devoted cousin, Brenda and (Greg) Colbert; special friends, Vienna Henderson, Fannett W. Freeman and a host of nieces, nephews, and friends.
