Lezora L Hall was born on September 18, 1946, and was the oldest child of Leroy and Louise Littlejohn. Mrs. Hall was a lifelong resident of Gainesville, Ga, and grew up and worshipped here at First Baptist Church. Mrs. Hall was also a proud graduate of E.E. Butler High School's Class of 1966. As a humble, hardworking, intelligent, loyal, strong, and proud woman, she definitely earned many bachelors of "Life" degrees throughout her 71 years here on this earth.

Mrs. Hall was a hard worker who spent years in the insurance industry as a book agent, going door to door selling life insurance. Some in the community say that she was the first African-American insurance agent in the Gainesville area. To supplement her income and to provide for her family as a single mother, she also worked as a domestic help in many tony homes in the Gainesville area. Mrs. Hall was also active in her community. For example, she was a Cub Scouts Den Leader and mentor for many young men in the Melrose Public Housing community as early as the 1980s. She always kept her children involved in positive extracurricular activities from church to sports.

She is survived by her three children; Vivian Drake of Gainesville, Avery (Kristi) Hall of Kernersville, NC, and Dwayne (Ciarra) Tate of Stone Mountain, Ga; six sisters and brothers: Leroy Littlejohn Jr. of Greenville, SC, Minister

Linda Littlejohn Jackson of Lithonia, Ga, Jackie (Cindy) Littlejohn of East Lansing , MI, Vivian (Bobby) Hughey of Stone Mountain, Ga., Rassie P.
