Peggy Ann Jackson, the second oldest of eight children, was born in Jefferson, Georgia, on May 5, 1946. Peggy received her heavenly wings on April 17, 2021.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Reverend Willie T. Jackson and Bobbie C. Jackson; three sister, Willie Ree Jackson, Corine Lott, and Francis Gaudlock; a couple of dear friends and co-worker, Patricia Woodland, the two of which treated each other as sisters; and close friend, Mildred Hill.

Peggy was born in Jefferson, Georgia, and moved to Gainesville, Georgia and then to Baltimore, Maryland. She graduated from Maryland High School. She attended Prince George's Community College, receiving an Associate Degree as a Paralegal Assistant.
