As he continued questioning the person on the other end of the phone, myself and the other nurses at the station realized that he was -in fact- taking nurse to nurse report on an incoming patient from the ED. 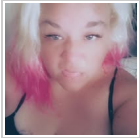

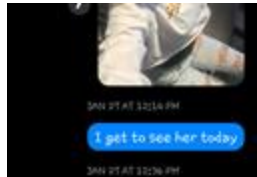
